- To insist that my child plays in as safe and healthy an environment as possible.
- To provide a safe, drug, tobacco and alcohol free environment.
- To remember that the game is for young people, not adults.
- To do my best to make baseball fun for my child.
- To require that all youth coaches are appropriately DBS checked, trained in Safeguarding, and complete a coaching qualification within 1 year.
